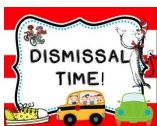
**NWEA:** We will begin NWEA assessments next week. This is a personalized assessment experience by adapting to each student's learning level—precisely measuring student progress and growth for each individual. This will allow our teachers to know what your child is ready to learn and teach at their level. We will also have a Skills Navigator program that will provide teachers and students with remediation and enrichment activities with the skills targeted from the assessment.



**ICAC:** The Indiana State Police have announced the Indiana Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) statewide youth education initiative designed to reduce cyber victimization of youth between the ages of 8-18. Three specially trained ICAC Youth Educators will present this program to our students in grades 3-5 on Thursday, September 15 in an effort to prevent victimization in the areas of online bullying, online sexual solicitation, online extortion, and more.
