50 words, Decoding Nonsense Word Fluency (NWF-CLS)

Grades 2 & 5 Language Arts and K, 2 & 5 Math Identification:

96% and above on NWEA Test, Measures of Achievement OR 85% and above on CogAT Test, Measures of Ability OR 80% and above on CogAT AND 80% and above on NWEA Tests AND teacher recommendation

Criteria to test students: NWEA data, 80% and above MCLASS data, above level
